RE: Allowable Variance of THC Potency

The allowable variance for THC potency between the actual results and the intended serving is to be no more than + or - 2.5%.

The West Virginia Office of Medical Cannabis has determined that a THC potency variance of + or - 2.5% is allowable. The allowable 2.5% variance for total THC in a 'container' will use the printed packaging label as the intended target and the median for calculation purposes. This means that harvest batch lab results up to 2.5% above or 2.5% below the intended target may use the current item labeling in Metrc and associated package labeling.

Any variance outside this + or -2.5% must have a new item created in Metrc and accurate labeling/packaging with the THC potency.

This allowable variance amount will go into effect December 20, 2023. All harvests must conform to this advisory as of that effective date.
