



## Safe Storage Checklist

- In original child-resistant packaging
- Clearly labeled container
- In a locked cabinet, box, safe, or bag.
- Out of reach of children or pets
- In a cool, dark, and dry place
- In an airtight container away from direct sunlight
- In the trunk while driving

*(Please note that traveling outside of West Virginia with medical cannabis obtained legally in this state is unlawful.)*



# SAFE STORAGE

## Storing Medical Cannabis Safely

Medical cannabis **must be in the original child-resistant packaging and should be locked in a cabinet, box, safe, or bag** after every use as an extra preventative measure. It is important to put cannabis back its safe storage location, even if you plan to use it again that day.

**Cannabis products should never be left unattended** in easy to reach spaces like the kitchen or bedside table.

## Treat Cannabis Like Other Medications

**Just like any other medication, drug, or chemical**, medical cannabis must be secured and **out of sight and reach**. It is important to store cannabis safely away from children and pets to prevent unwanted exposure and reduce the risk of an adverse event.

**Do not** disclose where your medical cannabis is stored or the combination/keys to your secure storage location to children.

## Know the Signs

Symptoms of accidental consumption of cannabis in children include lethargy, trouble breathing, poor coordination, and fast heartrate.

If a child has accidentally consumed cannabis, call the **poison control hotline: 1-800-222-1222**. In emergent situations **Call 911 or report to the nearest ER**.
