Physicians

How can a physician participate in the Medical Cannabis Program? When will applications be available?

In order to participate in the Medical Cannabis Program, a physician must:

- Submit an online application to the Bureau for Public Health, Office of Medical Cannabis.
- Demonstrate by training or expertise that he or she is qualified in treating the applicable serious medical conditions.
- Successfully complete the required four-hour course established by the Bureau.
- Hold a valid, unexpired, unrevoked, unsuspended West Virginia license to practice medicine.

Is the required four-hour training course currently available?

The required training course is currently not available. Once available, a link will be provided to the approved course(s).

Will a list of registered physicians be made available?

The Office of Medical Cannabis will establish and maintain an electronic database that includes a list of physicians who are registered with the Medical Cannabis Program.
